Dear Customer at # 13 Adams St. and Neighbors on Benjamin W. Pickett in South Portland

Beginning the week of July 28th the Portland Water District (PWD), in partnership with Southern Maine Community College (SMCC), will be replacing an old 2" water main on Adams Street with a new 8" water main and public fire hydrant. SMCC has contracted Dearborn Construction to replace the main from Benjamin W. Pickett St. to the upper entrance to the SMCC parking lot. The contractor will also be installing a new 1" copper service pipe from the new main to the property line of # 13 Adams St.

The project is expected to last three weeks. We will make every attempt to minimize your inconveniences during the main replacement project. We will need to interrupt service in the area to make the initial connection to the main in Benjamin W. Pickett St. The District's inspector we will provide you with at least 48-hours notice prior to that connection.

This project is important to ensure upgraded water quality and improved fire protect in the area. We appreciate your cooperation. Should you have any questions or comments, please contact me at the number or email below.
