## MAKE SURE YOUR TOILET DOESN'T LEAK.

Most leaks happen in the toilet. To test your toilet, color tank water with food coloring and let stand for 10 minutes. If color seeps into the bowl, you have a leak.



## TURN OFF WATER WHEN NOT USING IT.

Don't let the water run while brushing your teeth or shaving.

The Portland Water District offers its customers, at cost, water conservation devices. These items will help reduce your water usage, which could lower your water, sewer and electric bills!

Kit includes the following:

- ◆ Non-toxic leak detection tablets
- ◆ Instruction card and bag
- ◆ Aerators

Massage shower head provides greater force at lower water pressure.
