Notice to Bidders

Sealed bids for the construction of the **High Street, Windham Water Main Renewal** to be received by the Portland Water District, 225 Douglass Street, Portland, Maine until **10:00 a.m. local time, Thursday, January 12, 2023.**

Bids may be hand delivered one (1) hour prior to Bid opening time only (from 9:00am to 10:00am on January 12, 2023.) The Purchasing Agent, Wesley Gilbert, will receive Bids in person at the customer service entrance at 225 Douglas Street, Portland, Maine 04014 by contacting Wesley in advance at 207-523-5203. Bid opening will be hosted on Cisco Webex Meetings. The Bid Opening Webex Meeting ID is 2632 181 2418 and can be entered with passcode: 38nMJPVRfm4 (38665787 from phones and video systems). The work shall generally consist of, but is not necessarily limited to,

1. Installation of approximately 1,125 feet of 12-inch ductile iron water main,
2. Installation of water services, valves, hydrants, temporary water main, and other related appurtenances along the water main.

The Portland Water District will supply the Contractor with all ductile iron pipe and standard gaskets (USP). The Contractor will supply all other materials.

The expected pipe delivery date is February 15, 2023. If pipe delivery is delayed beyond April 1, 2023, the project completion dates will be adjusted through a change order.

Each proposal must be accompanied by Proposal Guaranty in form of certified check or bid bond in amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. A performance bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, and labor and material payment bonds in like amount will be required prior to execution of the Agreement.

Bidder agrees to begin and complete work with the time frame outlined in the Agreement.

The Bidder is responsible for determining if there are Addenda to the Project by viewing the P.W.D. project website located at www.pwd.org/construction-bids. The bidder is responsible for incorporating addenda into their Bid and referencing the number and date on Article 3 – Bidder’s Representations of the Bid form. The Portland Water District will not post Bid Addenda any later than two (2) days prior to the bid opening without individually notifying all plan holders.

No bids may be withdrawn within sixty (60) days after date of opening thereof. Right is reserved to refuse or reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in proposals received and to award work at the discretion of the General Manager acting in the best interests of the Portland Water District.
