



Water Rate Adjustment

The Portland Water District is proposing a 3.7 percent increase in revenue, effective March 1, 2022. The impact on typical customers is shown in the table below. This increase does not affect wastewater fees which are determined by city and town governments.

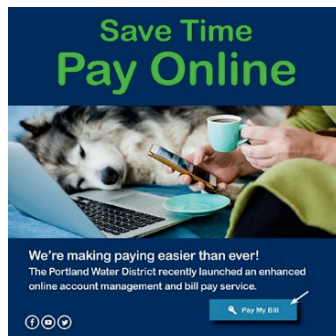
