Internship Opportunities for engineering/environmental students



The Portland Water District (PWD) has openings for paid interns in engineering and water & wastewater operations. The successful candidates will work 12 weeks in Maine's largest public water and wastewater utility, gaining valuable industry exposure and experience. The District is willing to help the successful applicants gain internship credit hours, if requested.

The positions will run from mid-May to mid-August. The positions will be a standard 40-hour work week with potential for some overtime. Candidates in the engineering or environmental programs are best suited for this position.

Wastewater

A position is available in the collection systems and pumping group and in the wastewater treatment group. Projects will relate to asset management, documentation, and other related areas.

Water

A position is available in the water services department. Projects will include a combination of field, treatment plant and office tasks related to asset management, documentation, and other related areas.

Engineering

Several positions are available focusing on a variety of asset management and engineering projects. Work will include using GPS data collection tools and GIS and asset management software. This position provides exposure to a range of engineering and construction services provided by PWD.

Internships with PWD have led to full time employment both at the District and with other utilities and consultants in the water and wastewater industry.
