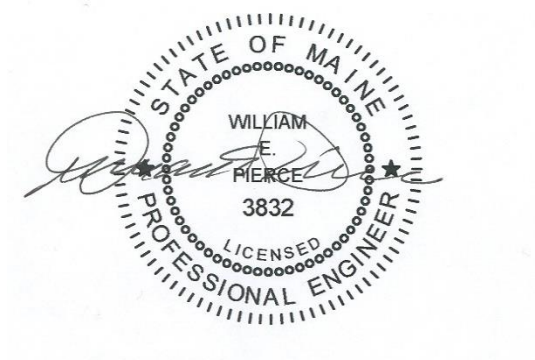

ADDENDUM NO. 2

March 8, 2021

General

The Portland Water District has received the following questions from interested parties and is addressing each question as noted:

1. Question: What are the budgets for these two projects?

Answer: The Portland Water District's budget for Ledgewood Drive (Contract A) is \$300,000; the budget for Diamond Street (Contract B) is \$400,000.

2. Question: Will QC testing for the pavements be required on either contract?

Answer: Testing is not required by the contract. However, if any initial tests done by the Owner indicate specifications have not been met, the contractor will be responsible for any retesting required to prove compliance with the specifications.

Also, The Portland Water District has been advised by the Town of Falmouth that there will be a street opening charge of \$25.00 per square yard for the water main installation in Middle Road; and the service line for 19 Ledgewood Drive on the north side of the Ledgewood Drive centerline. (The street opening fee for the water main installation on the south side of Ledgewood Drive is being waived by the Town.)
